

## Introduction

From 1st June 2015, Classification Labelling Packaging (CLP) replaced CHIP (the Chemicals Hazard Information and Packaging for Supply) Regulations 2009.

## Who it is for

This course is for anyone who works with, or may come into contact with, chemicals that may be hazardous. All chemical labels should now be in the new format and you will need to have an understanding of these.

## Course aim

The aim of this course is to give you a good understanding of the new Classification Labelling Packaging (CLP) Regulations.

## Course content

- Hazard symbols and their meanings
- CLP Classification

## Course duration

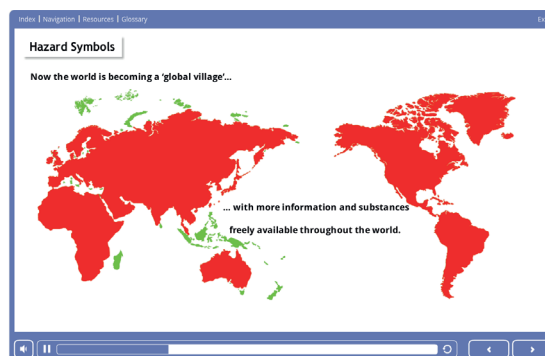
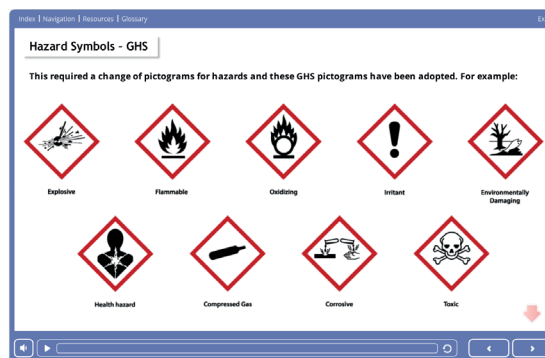
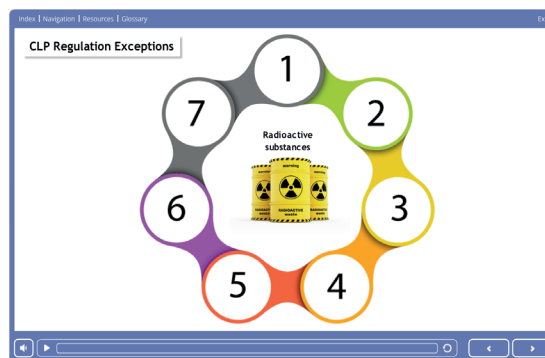
The average time required to complete the learning is approximately **10 - 15 minutes**, however the course is designed to go at the pace of the learner and can be completed in more time if needed.

## Assessment

The online assessment for the course consists of **13 multiple choice** questions. In order to be successful, candidates must achieve a **75% pass mark (10 or above)** to obtain the certificate.

## Certification

On successful completion of the assessment, the candidate will be able to print/save their certificate. In addition to this, an e.mail is sent to the candidate containing a link to the certificate. This is the simplest, most convenient way to achieve compliance. Also, a QR code has been added to the certificate, which can be scanned by a smartphone to establish the certificate's validity.
